SAFELY DECOMMISSIONING SEMICONDUCTOR TOOLS & FACILITIES

BACKGROUND.

A global initiative on decommissioning and decontamination "best practices" was begun at SEMICON Europa 2002. Since then, a SEMI EH&S Task Force has conducted workshops in Europe, Asia, and North America to gather global industry concerns and lessons-learned. More than 200 industry professionals have been involved to date.

WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES.

This special, full day SESA Workshop will provide participants with an opportunity to learn what their peers, suppliers, and customers throughout the world consider to be the key issues involved with decommissioning and decontamination. It will also offer each participant an opportunity to provide timely comment to the Task Force as it completes its white paper on *Decommissioning Best Practices* for submission to the SEMI EH&S International Standards Committee at SEMICON West in July 2003.

Join representatives of the SEMI Decommissioning Task Force to review industry concerns, lessons-learned, and open issues on this important subject. Topics will include a review of existing guidance plus presentations and interactive discussions relating to the management, compliance, decontamination, logistics, and training issues involved with any decommissioning activity.
